"A few days passed without receiving any confirmation of my order or shipping details," Eliza said. "That's when I began to worry."

When she attempted to contact customer service, she found that the website was down. The email address provided was no longer valid, and the social media accounts had vanished. Eliza realized she had fallen victim to a scam. The website was fake, and her money was gone.

Eliza's experience highlights several important lessons:

Be wary of deals that seem too good to be true. If the prices are significantly lower than those on other reputable sites, it's a red flag. Scammers often lure victims with unbelievable deals.

Research the seller. Before making a purchase, check the seller's online presence. Read reviews, ensure they have a solid reputation, and confirm if the business is listed with the Better Business Bureau

Avoid impulse purchases. During the holidays, it can be easy to make rushed decisions. Take your time to think through your purchases and ensure they are legitimate.
